

# 28<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL SOUTHERN OREGON JUNIOR RODEO

## ISOLA ARENA @ JACKSON COUNTY EXPO IN CENTRAL POINT, OR

PERFORMANCE TIMES ARE AUGUST 1<sup>ST</sup> 2009 @ 11am. & AUGUST 2<sup>ND</sup> 2009 @ 10am.

Entry forms will be returned if not ALL the following do not comply:

1. Entries must be postmarked no later than Monday July 20, 2009. ABSOLUTELY NO PHONE IN ENTRIES ACCEPTED. Must have entry and money into secretary for contestant to be entered in rodeo.
2. Entry fee in the correct amount must accompany entry form. MONEY ORDER OR CASHIER'S CHECK ONLY. **NO PERSONAL CHECKS!!!!!!!!!!!!!!** Stock/Office fees will not be refunded. Absolutely no refunds after July 24, 2009.
3. AGE: Juniors 8-13 as of 1-1-09. Seniors 14-18 as of 1-1-09. **COPY OF BIRTH CERTIFICATE OR A NOTARY MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY FORM.**
4. SET UPS- for the good of the rodeo ONLY. Limited Set-Ups. ENTRIES WITH REASON WILL BE CONSIDERED. YOU MAY CALL BACK Wednesday JULY 29, 2009 FROM 6:00 PM TO 9:00 PM TO FIND OUT WHEN YOU ARE UP. (541)973-5086.
5. AWARDS- All-Around Saddle to Sr. Boy, Sr. Girl, Jr. Boy and Jr. Girl will be given. Buckles to all 1<sup>st</sup>, place Jr. & Sr. winners.
6. Payback will be 100% of entry fee.  
Payoffs based on number of contestants per event. 1-5 contestants' pays 1 place, 6-10 contestants pays 2 places, ect. (See chart at rodeo office).
7. All- Around will be decided on points. 1<sup>st</sup> place= 12 points and 6<sup>th</sup> place= 2 points. Must enter at least 2 events or more.
8. **TIE BREAKERS-** For event buckles a flip of a coin. For All-Around we will count number of 1<sup>st</sup> places on down until tie is broken.
9. Chute draw will be used.
10. Event monies and buckles will be given out as event finishes on **SUNDAY-** A delay will arise during last two events to update All-Around. All-Around awards will be given out following SUNDAY performance. If you can not be present to receive your award, you may specify someone to do so for you. All monies not picked up by contestant winning money will be mailed.—NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!!!!!!!
11. There will be a participation award for all pee wee entries and a *champion* award for the Pee Wee Barrel Racer, Mutton Buster, Calf Rider, and Dummy Roping winners.
12. Senior Team Ropers- You must verify your partner(s) before entering. If entries do not match we will not enter you or find you a partner.

### RULES & REGULATIONS SOUTHERN OREGON JUNIOR RODEO

1. The Southern Oregon Junior Rodeo is ruled/ governed by its judges, flaggers, and directors. A more complete set of rules will be posted at the rodeo.
2. There will be a RULES Meeting with the arena Director, Flaggers, and Judges prior to each Performance.
3. **IT'S THE CONTESTANTS RESPONSIBILITY TO PHONE IN (CALL BACK). NO CHANGES WILL BE MADE IN PERFORMANCE OR SLACK BECAUSE OF FAILURE TO CALL BACK.**
4. Any unnecessary roughness or abuse to stock will cause the contestant to be disqualified.
5. Each contestant will be called 3 times. If not present and ready on the third call disqualification will result in that event.
6. Any abusive language from the contestant or the contestant's family or friend will result in disqualification not only in that event but the entire Rodeo.
7. Contestant must wear appropriate western attire including western hat or helmet, long sleeve button shirt with collar, jeans, western boots, and rodeo number on their back. **\*\*NO CHANGING OF CLOTHES BEHIND THE CHUTES.\*\***
8. **ALL CONTESTANTS MUST WALK THRU THE ARENA GATE BEFORE BEGINNING THEIR RUNS OR A DISQUALIFICATION WILL RESULT. THIS IS FOR SAFETY.**
9. **HAT RULE- ALL CONTESTANTS MUST BEGIN THEIR COMPETITIVE RUN WITH HAT ON HEAD. INTENTIONALLY LOSING HAT MAY RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION. JUDGES DECISION.**
10. **IT IS THE CONTESTANTS RESPONSIBILITY TO MAKE SURE THAT THE FLAGGER IS READY OR YOU WILL BE DISQUALIFIED. THIS MEANS FLAG IS IN THE AIR.**
11. **EVENTS:**
  - A. MUTTON BUSTIN—Contestant will ride from the bucking chute. Longest timed ride wins. Must clear gate. Can not cross over to Pee Wee Calf Riding.
  - B. DUMMY ROPING—Two age groups, 5 and under and 6-8 may not be entered in the rodeo.
  - C. PEE WEE BARRELS- Must be able to ride alone. Clover leaf pattern and rules to govern. 5 second penalty for knocked down barrel.
  - D. PEE WEE CALF RIDING- Loose rope provided. Longest timed ride wins. Must clear gate. Can not cross over to Pee Wee Mutton Bustin.
  - E. BREAKAWAY Roping- Two loops allowed if carrying second. 30 second time limit. Rope must cross over animals head, then catch as catch can.
  - F. GIRLS GOAT TYING- 60 second time limit for Juniors. 30 second time limit for Seniors. Leather thong, piggin string or rope may be used. 10 second penalty if horse comes in contact with goat or rope holding the goat.
  - G. JR. BOYS GOAT TYING-60 second time limit. Piggin string must be used. 10 second penalty if horse comes in contact with goat or rope holding the goat.
  - H. BARREL RACING- Clover leaf pattern will be used. 5 second penalty for each knocked down barrel. Horse may not be used twice in same age group. **NO RUNNING THRU GATE.** May circle once.
  - I. POLE BENDING- 5 second penalty for each knocked down pole. Horse may not be used twice in same age group. **NO RUNNING THRU GATE.** May circle once
  - J. CHUTE DOGGIN- Will start from bucking chute. Can throw when steers head crosses designated line. 30 second time limit.
  - K. BULL RIDING- 8 second ride. Contestant must provide own equipment. Mouthpiece and Vest required. Flank will be provided.
  - L. BAREBACK RIDING- 8 second ride. Contestant must provide own equipment. Mouthpiece and Vest required. Flank will be provided.
  - M. SADDLE BRONC RIDING- 8 second ride. Contestant must provide own association approved saddle and rein. Mouthpiece and Vest required. Flank will be provided.
  - N. JR STEER RIDING- 8 second ride. May ride with 1 or 2 hands. Contestant must provide own equipment. Mouthpiece and Vest required. Flank will be provided.
  - O. JR CALF RIDING- 8 second ride. May ride with 1 or 2 hands. Contestant must provide own equipment. Mouthpiece and Vest required. Flank will be provided
  - P. JR STEER STOPPING- One loop allowed. Three legal head catches. 30 second time limit.
  - Q. TIE DOWN ROPING- Two loops allowed if carrying second. Catch as catch can after rope crosses over animals head. 30 second time limit.
  - R. TEAM ROPING- Three legal head catches. 3 loops. 60 second time limit for Juniors and 30 second time limit for Seniors. Contestant's responsibility to confirm partners before entering.
  - S. SADDLE COW- Sr. Boys. 6 second ride. Must supply own saddle. Hazer must be a contestant. Hazer may not touch cow. Rider and hazer must both have a hold of saddle when they cross over finish line for time to count. Mouthpiece and vest required. No points to ALL-AROUND.
  - T. RIBBON ROPING- NO POINTS TO ALL AROUND. 100% ENTRY FEE TO POT. Boy/Girl team. Western attire including boots, runner may wear tennis shoes. Both contestants must be entered in the rodeo. Either member may be roper. No dragging must stay facing steer.
